

# Scupper Hole Measuring Guide



This PDF file should be printed at 100% scale

To check the scale of the print-out measure the line below to be sure it measures 1 inch.



With scale confirmed you are ready to cut-out and glue the scale to a piece of heavy paper or card board. This will keep the scale as flat as possible.

Then simply insert the scale into your scupper hole to see where it hits the side of the scupper hole. This will tell you the approximate size of your scupper hole. Be sure to check each scupper hole and record the number of plugs needed.

If you will be purchasing your own scupper plugs to build a custom set we recommend choosing a plug that falls with your measurement in the middle of the taper range.
